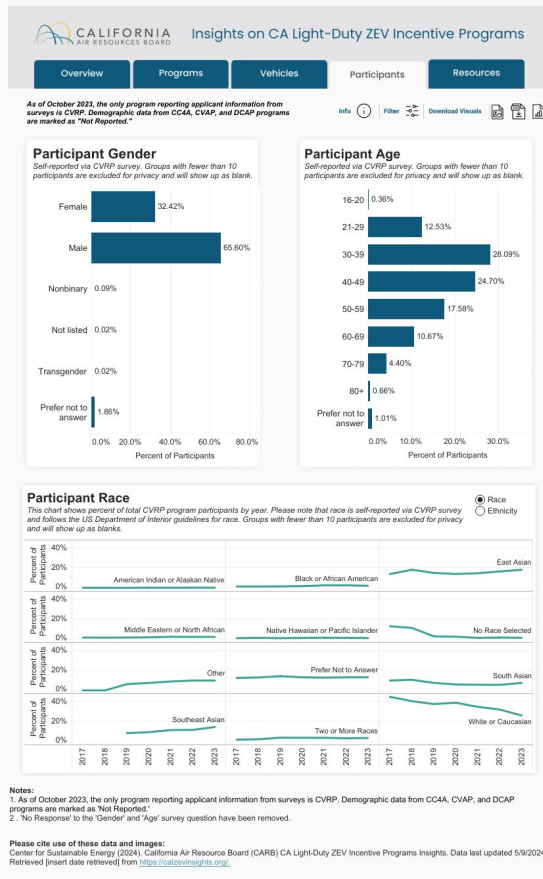

These visualizations show program statistics as they relate to approved applications as of the last update (5/6/2024). Use the navigation buttons at the very top to move between the incentive statistics, the map, and notes about the program. The button that is highlighted in green shows what page you are currently on.

The filters allow you to drill down into the data:

- For the Approved Date filter, you can use the slider to adjust the dates or click on the date itself and use the pop-up calendar to adjust the value.
- For the remaining filters, click the drop-down arrow, select the values you want to apply to the data, and then click "Apply". \*Note that the drop-down list will remain until you click elsewhere on the dashboard.
- Select the "Reset Filter(s)" button to return the filters to their default settings.
- You can also filter the visuals by clicking on the graphs themselves.

**Program Details:**  
In December 2019, the Vermont Agency of Transportation (VTrans) launched an incentive program to consumers for the purchase of eligible new plug-in electric vehicles (PEVs). The initial \$1,100,000 for incentives was depleted in October 2020. The State appropriations bill enacted on October 2, 2020 included another \$950,000 for incentives and an additional \$2.7 million was included in the Fiscal Year 2022 Transportation Bill. As of October 25, 2022, there was \$10,848,700 available for the incentives.

Consumers have the option to apply the incentive directly to their purchase at a participating retailer or receive a check directly.

- For **Consumer-Direct incentives**, the consumer submits an incentive application form after the consumer takes delivery of their vehicle.
- For **Retailer Point-of-Sale incentives**, the retailer provides the incentive to the consumer at point of sale and then submits an application for reimbursement from the incentive program within 15 days of the date of sale.

State incentives are available on new vehicle purchase or leases of eligible models with a base MSRP of \$40,000 or less for Plug-In Hybrid Electric Vehicles and \$45,000 or less for All-Electric Vehicles. Vehicle MSRP exemptions are only available for individuals with disabilities that require special registration plates and placards as defined in 23 V.S.A. §304a.
